We want to make you aware of an increase in scam emails being sent to LLCs, corporations, and other business owners regarding Beneficial Ownership Information ("BOI") filings.

These emails often claim that you are required to file a BOI report immediately and request payment, Social Security numbers, driver's license information, or other sensitive personal information. Many of these messages appear official and use urgent language designed to pressure recipients into responding.

Please use caution before responding to any BOI-related email.

Most U.S. companies are not required to file BOI reports with FinCEN under current federal regulations. Because of this, please treat any unsolicited email demanding immediate BOI compliance with extreme caution.

If you receive an email regarding a BOI filing request:

- Do not click on any links or open attachments.
- Do not provide Social Security numbers, driver's license information, banking information, or other sensitive data.
- Do not make any payment in response to an unsolicited BOI filing email.

Scammers often target business owners by creating emails that resemble government notices or business compliance requirements. Even if an email appears professional or references a government agency, it may not be legitimate. Before responding, providing information, or making a payment, verify the request through the official IRS website or the applicable Secretary of State website and avoid clicking on links contained in the email.
